

German artists. The exhibition did not display any particular curatorial construct, but instead contained each artist's individual work and practice as a standalone and yet mutual occupation of the gallery. What each artist did share was an intensive year of "art and art perception" in New York, sponsored by a German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) grant in 2003/2004. Although there was nothing specifically new about the type of works in this exhibition, it did show an interesting level of experimentation by each artist in forms and media that are familiar in contemporary visual culture.
