

Margaret Corcoran's previous solo show, four years ago, explored the relationship between looking and painting, and her latest exhibition continues the line of inquiry. The most striking piece, At the Spar: Tong (above), features a Chinese woman behind the counter of a convenience store. This work hangs beside serene landscapes suggestive of Asia and the work that gives the show its title, a scene from a leafy Chinese campus. The contrast between the paintings suggests the way in which migrant workers are defined solely in terms of the services they provide. Corcoran riffs on her familiar interest in appropriating and adapting art-history sources: the Spar piece is, in some ways, an update of works by Manet and Degas that feature women at work. The repetition of certain subjects, such as Emma and her sister from the Spar series, allow Corcoran to experiment with various levels of realism and abstraction.
